# Letter From The President

Dear Friends,

Greeting from the Kansas Pediatric Foundation! Many things have changed in our world in the last year, but our commitment to improving child health has remained steady. We are grateful to all who continue to work together with the goal that children grow up to reach their full potential across Kansas. We are currently collaborating with 713 physicians and medical providers to put books into the hands of Kansas kids. Contributions from several foundations throughout the state and many individual donors continue to help us grow.

The Kansas Pediatric Foundation's largest program, Turn a Page. Touch a Mind.® (TAP-TAM), now has 140 sites across the state. In July, TAP-TAM began including books for the newborn to six-month age range. Participating physicians and medical providers will give more than 150,000 books to Kansas kids this year while encouraging families to spend time reading together each day.

For the third year, the Kansas Kids Fund offered the Pediatricians in Action Grant opportunity. Two grantees were awarded this year. Dr. Jessica Howlett will be using grant funds to pilot a maternal depression screening project for parents of NICU patients through the Overland Park Regional Medical Center. Dr. Stephanie Kuhlmann, along with the Kansas COVID Workgroup for Kids, held a summer event to bring superintendents from the Wichita area together to discuss lessons learned in 2020-2021 and to plan for the new school year. Thank you to all who donated to the Kansas Kids Fund through the Kansas Pediatric Foundation for making these opportunities possible.

As we look to the future, our goals include continuing to reach more families with the TAP-TAM book program, and strengthening the Kansas Kids Fund, which will allow the Kansas Pediatric Foundation to grow to include additional programs that will help Kansas kids reach their full potential.

We know that we cannot accomplish these goals alone, and we will continue to seek collaborations with partners who share our vision. Together we can make an impact that will last for generations in Kansas.

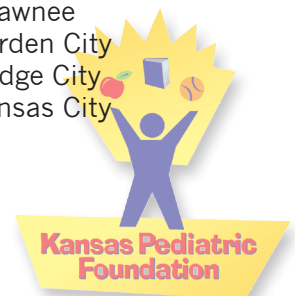

Turn a Page. Touch a Mind. ® (TAP-TAM), has grown this year to include 713 participating physicians and medical providers in Kansas. More than 133,000 new, developmentally appropriate books were distributed to children at well-check appointments from their primary care provider in the last year. We were also excited to expand the age range of recipients to include newborns this year. Since 2004 TAP-TAM has put 1.2 million books into the hands of Kansas kids!
