### Letter From The President

Dear Friends,

Greeting from the Kansas Pediatric Foundation! Like you, our commitment to improving child health has remained steady throughout challenging times. We are grateful to all who continue to work together with the goal that children grow up to reach their full potential across Kansas. We are currently collaborating with 757 physicians and medical providers to put books into the hands of Kansas kids. Contributions from several foundations throughout the state and many individual donors continue to help us grow.

The Kansas Pediatric Foundation's largest program, Turn a Page. Touch a Mind.® (TAP-TAM), now has 140 sites across the state providing books for the newborn to six-month age range. Participating physicians and medical providers will give nearly 170,000 books to Kansas kids this year while encouraging families to spend time reading together each day.

For the fourth year, the Kansas Kids Fund offered the Pediatricians in Action Grant opportunity. Two grantees were awarded this year. Dr. Morgen Govinden will be using grant funds to implement "The Zones of Regulation" curriculum within an elementary school setting to help students regulate their energy, body and emotions. Dr. Jennifer Mellick will be using funds to package and distribute "Animal Moves and Wellness Program" to give families in underserved communities tools and resources to improve their overall wellness and create bonds that strengthen family ties.

As we look to the future, our goals include continuing to reach more families with the TAP-TAM book program, and strengthening the Kansas Kids Fund, which will allow the Kansas Pediatric Foundation to grow to include additional programs that will help Kansas kids reach their full potential.

We know that we cannot accomplish these goals alone, and we will continue to seek collaborations with partners who share our vision. Together we can make an impact that will last for generations in Kansas.

Turn a Page. Touch a Mind. ® (TAP-TAM), has grown this year to include 757 participating physicians and medical providers in Kansas. More than 153,000 new, developmentally appropriate books were distributed to children at well-check appointments from their primary care provider in the last year. Since 2004 TAP-TAM has put 1.4 million books into the hands of Kansas kids!
